1535 of Pirton sicke of body and beinge hole in mynd and of good remembrance

in heven and my body to be buryde in the parishe church yarde of Pyrton aforeseid

legacyes in this my p[rese]nt will p[er]formyde I give to Margay my wife which I

make and ordeyn my executrix and she to dispose it for the wealthe of my soul
